TRAMMELL CROW COMPANY ISSUES STATEMENT ON COLORADO CONVENTION CENTER

DENVER, December 12, 2018 – Trammell Crow Company Denver Senior Managing Director Bill Mosher said today that an employee who had improper communications with a bidder in the preliminary stages of the general contractor selection process related to the expansion of the Colorado Convention Center has been terminated.

“We are mortified that this occurred,” said Mr. Mosher. “In no way were the actions of the employee authorized by Trammell Crow Company. They are contrary to the values of our company and our longstanding business practices. We are cooperating fully with the City of Denver and continuing to conduct our own internal investigation.”

“For 60 years, Trammell Crow Company has been part of the fabric of the Denver community. We apologize to the people of Denver and City officials who place their trust in us, and we are sorry for the disruption to the convention center expansion project that has occurred because of the actions of our former employee.”
